# From the Principa



A friendly reminder that if your child is feeling unwell or showing symptoms of Covid, they must stay at home.

If students present at school unwell, we will contact you to collect them. This is a departmental requirement. If you are unable to collect your child/children, we will request that you have a family member or friend come to collect them.

For students displaying symptoms of Covid, we will provide a Rapid Antigen Test for you to take home. Please ensure you advise the school of the result. Students with Covid are able to return to school once they have tested negative.

#### A reminder of symptoms for Covid;

**Most Common Symptoms:** Fever, Cough, Tiredness, Loss of taste or smell

**Less common symptoms:** Sore Throat, Headache, Aches & Pains, Diarrhoea, Red irritated eyes, Rash on skin or discolouration of fingers or toes.

Term 1 has been very unpredictable with the start of the school year being delayed by 2 weeks and recent wet weather resulting in school closures. As a result, a few of our planned school activities have had to be rescheduled.

Cross Country is now scheduled to take place Week 1 of Term 2 at this stage. The Cross Country will now be a 'Cross Country Colour Run'. Please keep an eye out for permission forms. These will hopefully be sent out tomorrow. Students will require a white or black shirt, old shorts suitable for school and running in. They can wear sunglasses to protect their eyes if they wish. We unfortunately could not go ahead with our planned Easter Playgroup, however Playgroup will return in Term 2.



Our goal is to increase awareness around the opportunities for people with a disability and in the greater inclusion space, within sports and active recreation.
