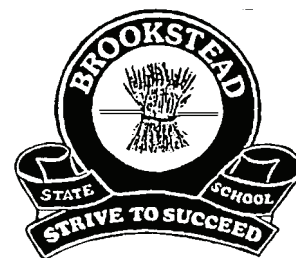

In order to meet Education Queensland's Code of School Behaviour, students need to:

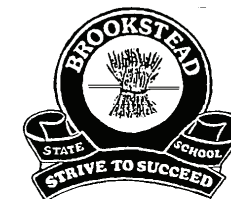
- *Follow adult directions*

STUDENTS

- To be safe and secure and happy in the school environment
- For self and property to be treated with respect and consideration
- To obtain maximum benefit from all learning experiences and to experience success.
- To express opinions and be heard.
- To be able to have support from appropriate source.
- To be treated with respect and courtesy.
- To expect assistance and support from parents and staff.

PARENTS

- To be informed
- To feel satisfied their children are working in a safe and secure environment.
- To be treated with respect and courtesy.
- To feel welcome in the school.

TEACHERS

- To teach.
- To feel secure (physically and emotionally).
- To express opinions in a professional manner and to be heard.

CONSIDERATION OF INDIVIDUAL CIRCUMSTANCES

Responses to inappropriate student behaviour must consider both the individual circumstances and actions of the student and the needs and rights of school community members.

CONSEQUENCES

APPROPRIATE BEHAVIOUR

Positive Rewards:

- Brag Tags
- Behaviour Monsters
- Encouragement, Praise and Acknowledgment
- Student of the Week
- Stickers
- Dig in the Box
- House Points
- Mention in Newsletter
- Entitlement to Privileges

INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOUR

Actions that may be taken:

- Rule Reminder

Minor / Move to AMBER

- Apologising (verbal/written)
- Relocation within / outside classroom

Major or Persistent / Move to RED

- Withdrawal from Playground / Time Out
- Restitution - clean up or repair
- Follow up with Teacher
- Incident recorded
- Losing Playground and Classroom privileges

Critical

- Parent informed
- Referral to Principal or other
- Losing Privileges (eg Non-essential, activities such as Arts Council, Excursions, Camps)
- Interview with Student and Parent/s
- Counseling program with Student and Parent/s
- Suspension
- Exclusion
